Background



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Community Health Education Services by Tele-health (CHEST) Nepal is a Social Non-Government Organisation (NGO). It was registered in the calendar year 2009 with the Government in Kathmandu, in the Kathmandu District Office and the Social Welfare Council of Nepal.

Since 2009, CHEST has launched an initiative utilizing information and communication technology for health as a platform for providing other services aimed at overall community development. A real-time telemedicine setup is used to provide consultation services for patients with skin diseases, and the same infrastructure is also used to provide education and other vocational training services to rural communities, as per their needs. After signing a formal memorandum of understanding between CHEST Nepal and the community, implementation of the project is planned. Several coordinators, who assess the needs and co-ordinate the implementation of the program at the community level, are selected among the village members for various aspects of the program; health, education, agriculture and other trainings. CHEST Nepal provides the technical expertise such as dermatological consultation, lectures and interaction with related experts through real-time teleconferencing from the DI Skin Hospital and Research Centre in Kathmandu (DISHARC).

After completing 1st International Conference on eHealth and Tele-Health (ICEHAT) on 1-3 November 2018, International Committee of eHealth and Tele-Health (ICEHAT), with the same conference acronym, has been formed under the umbrella of DISHARC on 2019. As per the idea and guidance from Guidance Councellor Prof. Gunter Burg and under the direct supervision and guidance from Chairman of (DISHARC/ CHEST/ ICEHAT), Prof. Anil Kumar Jha, the training / awareness program was organized by CHEST Nepal . The training was conducted at the Kaveri Inn, Kathmandu and the whole session lasted for two days, i.e. 1-2 June 2019.

In this programme, community health services initiatives, health care management and awareness, paediatric health, dental and oral hygiene as well as ICT training and awareness were discussed in detail as per the requirements of the community people. Pre-test and post-test of the program followed by interview with the participants was carried out during the period.

Trainers, participants and programme details has been provided into the annexes of this report.

Participant Details

A total of 24 participants took part in the training cum awareness programme. The delegates who participated in the programme were from the communities where CHEST Nepal works, namely, Gerkhutar, Nuwakot; Babhangama, Janakpur; and Mudikuwa, Parbat districts of Nepal. In each station total of six participants were selected. Out of six, two were community executives, other two were teachers and remaining two were students. In addition to that one participant from Lamjung community hospital and five popular community mobilizers nominated by chairman were selected for the broader dissemination of the initiative. Participant details will be presented in the annex of this report.



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


Fig: Participant locations across Nepal

Time Schedule

The two day training/ awareness program was conducted on two on-consecutive days; based on the availability of the community people and the CHEST team. This was also important because of the fact that the availability of the Chairman, Medical, Paeditric, Dental , Hospital Director and ICT Specialist including community members. With this the training was conducted on $1^{\rm st}$ and $2^{\rm nd}$ of June, 2019. Session startd at 9 am and ended at 7:00 pm on June 1 and started at 8:00 am and ended at 1:30 pm on $2^{\rm nd}$ June 2019 . Details program schedule is attached in the annex of this report.

Program Objective / Goal



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The main objective behind the training / awareness program was to get the delegates learn the essential ins and outs of the eHealth and Tele-health, Digital Health in broad, from start to end and what's in between. Along with that, the community people, teachers and the students needed to understand what to focus when managing the work of digital health, specially health and ICT related awareness to the community where they belong to . That is, being community members and community trainers (our ambassadors) their needs to be a balanced focus on all aspects of the initiative, from individual team members to the team itself to the task on hand. In addition to that, specific objectives are as follows;

- To provide in-depth training on basic and digital health related issues and health care management in the context of Nepal.
- To provide knowledge on ICT related technical issues to run the initiative, its operation as an ICT focal person.
- The aim of the training was to provide participants with a broad knowledge of the burning issues in ICT that will equip them to be confident and competent and enable them to make knowledge based society in the days to come.

Facilitation Techniques (Methodology)

There were several facilitation techniques used by the trainer which included multimedia presentations, question and answer, brainstorming, group discussions, case study discussions and interview to the participants. The multitude of training methodologies was utilized in order to make sure all the participants get the whole concepts and they practice what they learn, because only listening to the trainers can be forgotten, but what the trainees do by themselves they will never forget.

Scope and Limitation

The training and awareness program aims to provide in-depth knowledge of digital health and ICT awareness to the community people and more opportunities to them. The report outlines the activities and deliverables performed during the training based on the information provided by key informants (Participants). However, it does not include assessment from general people point of view. Neither does the report include overall community people of Nepal apart from Mudikuwa, Gerkhutar and Bavangama community members, teachers and students.

Facilitators



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Chairman of CHEST/DISHARC/ICEHAT, Director of DISHARC, Medical Doctor, Paedric Doctor, Dental Doctor and ICT Professional were directly involved in this program. Director Media and Communication of DISHARC, Administrative Officer, Accounts Officer including BoD and dermatologist of the DISHARC were also indirectly involved in this program. Detailed list of facilitators and support officials are given in the annex of this report.

Beneficiaries

It is learned during the training that one participant will make at least 15 community member aware about the issues. Therefore total number of participants were 24 in number and total number of direct beneficiaries will be 24 X 15 = 360. We have not calculated the indirect beneficiaries that will be produced by themselves in the days to come. As the participants are from community executives, teachers and students, the number will be good as per their profession and eagerness to share to the community. Exact number of beneficieries and impact will be assessed next year.

Activities

The two-day programme was publicly-engineered by MC Michael Chand, Director of Media and Communication, DISHARC. Detailed activities oulined by Mr. Chand is given below in his own words;

A two-day Orientation Training on Digital Health, ICT and Health Awareness Programme was held in Kathmandu on 1st - 2nd June 2018.

The Training was inaugurated by the Chairman of DISHARC, Prof. Dr. Anil Kumar Jha, MD, FRCP (Edin.)

Welcome Address

After the welcome address by Prof. Dr. Jha, the Director of DISHARC, Mr. Rishee Prasad Sapkota, made a head-start with his presentation on the "Introduction of Health Awareness Programme".

Remarks:

Very receptive to all.

Presentation

Prof. Dr. Anil Kumar Jha then began with a video presentation on the "Concept of Digital Health and it's Importance In Nepal".

A raw version of the Corporate Video on DISHARC was also presented by him on the occasion.

Remarks:

The video on Bamangama Tele-Medicine Centre drew everybody's attention. Corporate Video well received, despite its nascent stage.

Presentation



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Dr. Adarsh Kumar Jha in his presentation spoke on the "Basic Assessment Of Health Service. Health Service Arrangement of Nepal and Advancement of eHealth in Global Scenario".

Remarks:

Exceptionally demonstrative & and the message: "Beware of all prevailing circumstances on health - dos and don'ts".

The participants were enthusiastic when Dr. Adarsh Kumar Jha dwelt on the point "preventive methods during snake bites". An extensive discussion centered among the participants on whether it was a best option to look for a shaman or for an immediate health facility in an eventual snake bite.

Presentation

Dr. Sujit Shrestha, in his paper, spoke on the "Overview of Health in Paediatric Population".

Remarks

This was well received among the audience as it contained valuable information on post-natal care of a child in all circumstances.

Presentation

DISHARC Director, Mr. Rishee Prasad Sapkota did his presentation on the "Management Of Digital Health (eHealth and Tele-Health) Project Through CHEST Nepal".

Remarks:

Enthusiastic questions from the plenum.

Audience: A must-adopt system for all.

Presentation

Dr. Dharma Pratap Bharkher, Dental Surgeon, touched upon the topic "Awareness on the Oral Health and Dental Hygiene".

Remarks:

It was an Interactive session with many questions raised on dental hygiene.

Session 2 - 2nd June 2019

Presentation

The second day session began with the ICT Professional, Mr. Bhagirath Tiwari, dealing with the topic on "Technical Aspects Of The Digital Health and Cyber & ICT Awareness In The Context Of Nepal".

Remarks:

Statutory warning on the infringement of Cyber laws and social media in Nepal. Alarm signal for all. Plenum very thoughtful and vigilant.

Q &A Session



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Thereafter, a question & answer session was held with the community members of the Tele-Medicine & CHEST stations of Bavangama (Dhanusha), Gerkhutar (Nuwakot) & Mudikuwa (Parbat).

Remarks

Organise more training programmes in future!

The Orientation Training period was too short, they said. All were obliged to be together in one spot.

Historical participation

The two-day Orientation Training, not only brought the respectables of the stations together, but also six school juveniles (one boy and one girl each), who actively participated in the Training.

All six were interviewed by Michael Chand with encouraging answers recorded at the end.

The Training understood them to be the unofficial brand ambassadors, who were entrusted with the sharing of knowledge they all had gained in terms of health care and the careful use of the social media, e. g. Facebook and the stringent cyber rules and regulations being enacted by the Nepal Government soon. They were requested to share ideas on the CHEST activities in their respective areas.

Video Interview

Similarly, one representative each from the participating stations were interviewed on the occasion.

Brief comments and answers:

Unanimous in decision:

"A very informative and useful orientation for all of us! CHEST Nepal & DISHARC deserve our appreciation. However, the duration is too short for such a vast subject to comprehend just in two days" they all said. Video editing is in progress in this regard!

Test of General Knowledge (GK)

A day earlier to the Orientation Training, DISHARC, together with CHEST Nepal, held a written GK test, in order to find out how much knowledge the participants had on the ongoing training topics. The test on the same was held again on the day after the Orientation Programme was over, in order to determine their intensified knowledge on the training programme.

Closing of the programme



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The closing remarks were delivered by Prof. Dr. Anil Kumar Jha. He extended thanks and gratitude to all the participants, organising team, STRAPAL and Prof. Guenter Burg, followed later by the distribution of certificates.

CHEST-sponsored skill imparting training centers located at Bamangama, Dhanusha, Gerkhutar, Nuwakot, & Mudikuwa attended the Orientation Training. Pre-Test and Post-Test including interview of the key participants were also taken during the training. Outcome of the same will be made available in due course of time.

Conclusion

The training program was conducted successfully and all the participants took active part in all the two days of the training. the results from the pre-test and the post-test show that there were concepts and topics which the delegates didn't know about before the training and after the training they could explain the topics. We are very clear that the work of the delegates be monitored and any improvements will be followed-up. CHEST will monitor the impact and share with all concerned in the days to come.
